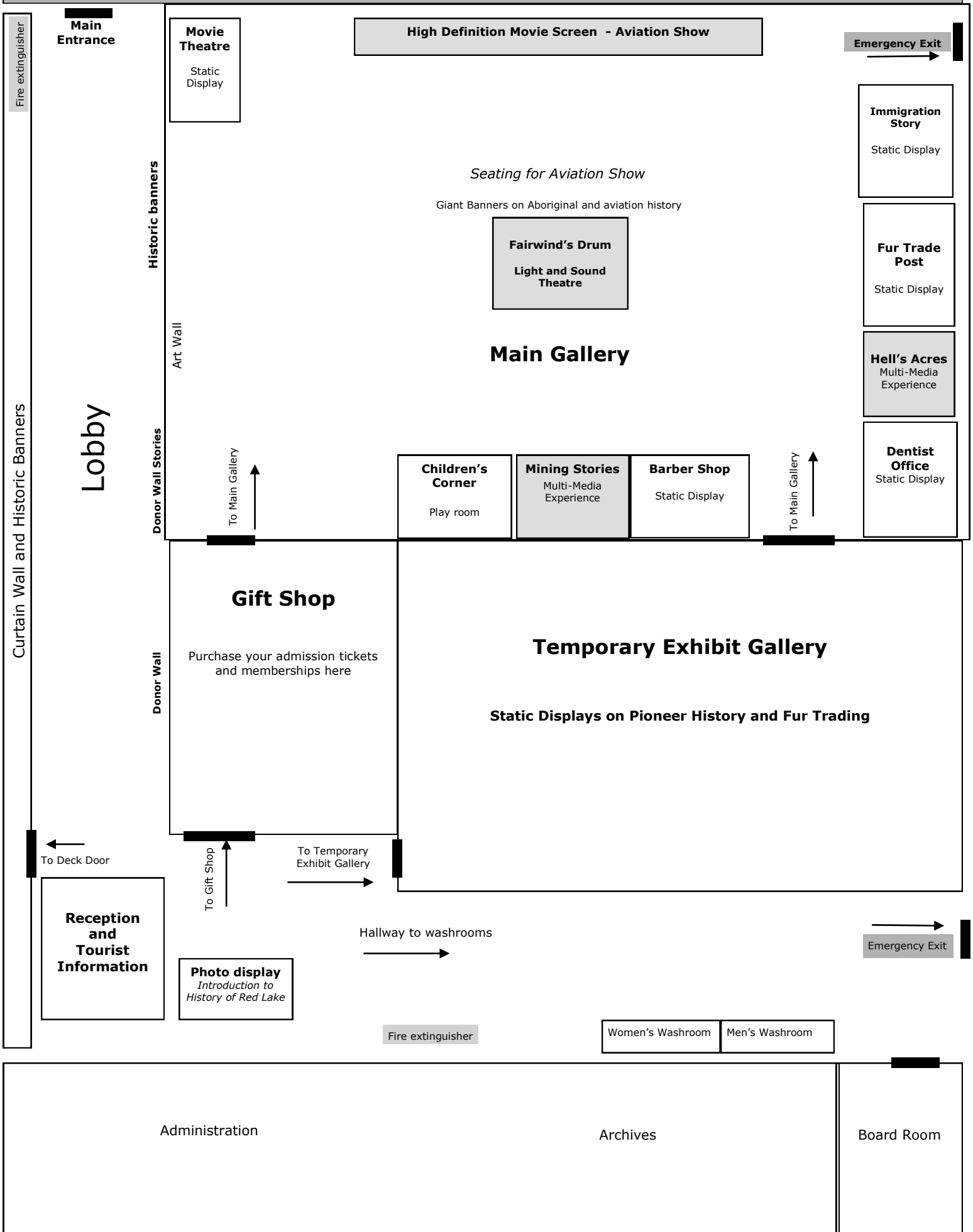


Red Lake Regional Heritage Centre Orientation Map
